- We provide year-round service agreements to collectors and processors
- We ensure the highest standards of environmental performance by giving preference to recyclers who exceed Oregon's Environmental Management Practices
- We work to make it as easy as possible for collectors to collect old electronics for recycling
- We ensure that responsible reuse is part of the program
- We have established a network of convenient drop-off locations around the state to make it easy for consumers and others covered by the law to recycle their old televisions and computers
- The State Contractor Program is funded by more than 180 manufacturers, most of whom are small businesses but funders also including several large computer manufacturers
- The Oregon DEQ has contracted with our organization, the **National Center for Electronics Recycling (NCER)** to design, implement, and manage the State Contractor Program for Electronics Recycling, or **Oregon E-Cycles**. To perform this work the NCER has enlisted the help of Portland-based **Zero Waste Alliance (ZWA)** and **Alcorn Consulting**.
